## Bracelet $S$ et



Materials: worsted weight
cotton (estimate: 5 yards
will be plenty), 4 mm hook
Size: one size

Gauge is not important for these bracelets. If you find that you would like it larger/smaller, adjust your hook size.

## Bracelet \#1

~ ch 5, ss in first ch to join into ring
~ ch 1 , working over tail, work 10 sc in ring, ss to first sc to join, pull tail to tighten circle
~ skipping the stitch you joined in, work (sc, 3dc, sc) in next st, *ss in next st, work (sc, 3dc, sc) in next st* Repeat * * around, ss to join to beginning of round
~ Chain 25, with wrong side of flower facing, ss to the center dc of the petal on the opposite side of flower, chain 25 ,, rotate flower and with wrong side of flower facing ss to stitch on the left of where you began chaining on the opposite side of flower, fasten off.

## Bracelet \#2

~ ch 30, ss in first ch to join into ring
~ch 1 , sc in same ch as joining, ch 14 , skip 14 ch , sc in next ch, ch 14 , ss in first st
~ ch 1 , sc in same st as joining, ch 14 , sc in sc, ch 14 , ss in first st, fasten off

## Bracelet \#3 (variation of Bracelet \#2)

~ ch 30, ss in first ch to join into ring
~ ch 1, sc in same ch as joining, ch 14, skip 14 ch, sc in next ch, ch 14, ss in first st
~ ch 1 , sc in same st as joining, ch 14, sc in sc, ch 14, ss in first st, fasten off
~ Repeat last round twice more.

## Bracelet \#4

long sc - work like a normal single crochet, but pull the loop until it is long enough to lay smoothly over the other stitches
~ ch 30, ss in first ch to join into ring
~ ch 1, sc in same ch as joining, sc in next 10 ch, ch 19, ss in first st
~ ch 1, sc in same st as joining, *sk next st, sc next 2 st, working around last 2 st, do a long sc in skipped st* Repeat * * twice, sc next st, ch 19, ss in first st
~ ch 1, sc in same st as joining, sc in next 10 st, ch 19, ss in first st, fasten off
