## Little Popcorn Square

Use any yarn; the weight of your yarn will determine the size of your square. My square with worsted weight and an I hook came out to about 4 inches across.

Notes:
Work over the ring on round 1 so that you can tighten the ring.

Popcorn = dc 4, take hook out of loop, insert in first dc and then back in loop, pull loop through first dc

Ch 8, ss to join

Round 1: ch 3, dc 3 into the ring, put hook into the top of the ch 3 , then put back into the working loop, pull loop through (first popcorn made), ch 2, [popcorn, ch 2], repeat brackets until you have 8 popcorns, after last ch 2, ss in first popcorn, fasten off.

Round 2: join new color in any ch 2 space, ch 3, dc 3 into the space, put hook into the top of the ch 3 , then put back into the working loop, pull loop through (first popcorn made), ch 2, popcorn in same space, ch 2, [ (popcorn, ch 2) twice in next space], repeat brackets until you have 16 popcorns, after last ch 2, ss in first popcorn, fasten off

Round 3: join new color in any ch 2 space, ch 1, ( 3 sc ) in same space, [ sc in popcorn, ( $2 \mathrm{sc}, 1 \mathrm{hdc}$ ) in sp, dc in popcorn, ( 3 dc ) in sp, dc in popcorn, (hdc, 2 sc ) in $\mathrm{sp}, \mathrm{sc}$ in popcorn, ( 3 sc ) in sp ], repeat brackets around, ending with the sc in popcorn, ss in first sc, fasten off.
