## Santa Face

Materials: H hook, worsted weight yarn in white, red, and skin color

Using skin color, ch 4, ss to join.



- 1 (RS) ch 3, 12 dc in ring, ss to ch 3, fasten off: 13 dc
- 2 (WS) Join white yarn. Ch 1, sc in same st, \*2 sc in next st, 1 sc in next st\* 4 times. Ch 1, turn: 13 sc
- 3 (WS) sc 1<sup>st</sup> st, \*ch 3, sk 1 st, sc next st\* 6 times, fasten off: 6 chain loops
- 4 (RS) With RS facing, join white yarn on the top right edge of beard, ch 1, ss in side of sc, ss flo across 6 st, ss in side of sc: 8 ss
- 5 (WS) ch 1, hdc flo across, switching to red on the last yarnover of the last st, ch 6 in red, turn: 8 white hdc, 6 red ch
- 6 (RS) sc 2<sup>nd</sup> ch and the next 4 ch, hdc next 7 st blo, sc blo in last st, ch 1, turn: 5 sc, 7 hdc, 1 sc
- 7 (WS) ss 1<sup>st</sup> st, sc next st, hdc next 4 st, sc next st, ss next st. Fasten off.

Tie some white yarn scraps to end of hat (or glue a tiny pompom on). Embroider a moustache and eyes and nose. I used a Sharpie for the eyes and nose. Tie a piece of yarn on for an ornament or sew to another project. You can also glue a magnet to the back and put on the fridge.
